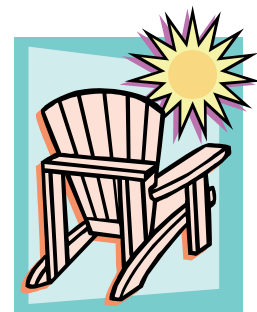
St. Gabriel's Passionist Parish
