

THE PASTOR'S CORNER

Peace and Goodness to all!

The Letter of James in this week's scripture readings is quite direct in its urging the community to realize its faith, in actions. James sums up his argument with the sentence: "Demonstrate your faith to me without works, and I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works." St Francis embodied this principle when he told the friars, "Preach the gospel at all times. Use words if necessary."

Stewardship is the keystone of our parish mission to realize the Gospel of the Lord Jesus. We pray and work to demonstrate our faith in service to the Lord and one another in all that we are and do as a faith community through stewardship.

Today we celebrate Stewardship Sunday and we invite all to attend the gathering in the parish center to discover the opportunities presented there for you and your loved ones to participate in the worship, life and work of our parish. Each of our parish organizations, ministries and committees have stations set up for you to discover and be invited to full participation in our parish liturgy, life, outreach and services.

This past week our Ministries Committee and Parish Council met jointly to discuss the efforts we are making to grow and improve our stewardship efforts to meet the changing needs and desires that you will express through the parish survey. The ministries committee was created to help us focus our services and outreach to realize our fullest potential in living the Gospel we proclaim. Your responses will help us to recognize the needs and directions you the parishioners find most important for us as a parish.

The follow up will require us to set realistic goals and objectives through our Stewardship programs to use our time, talent material resources and opportunities in ways that can strive to fulfill the gospel mandate to follow Jesus. This will be require time and effort from all of us together to build our faith community as a living witness to the faith we profess. It will not be an easy road, but it will be gloriously graced by the Holy Spirit. The words of Jesus in this Sunday's gospel spells it out: "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it."

Let us pray that the Lord will multiply the work of our hands and hearts as we strive to live the gospel with all we are and have and do.
