Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following the interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Saturday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with Msgr. Edgardo Pan, PH for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person.

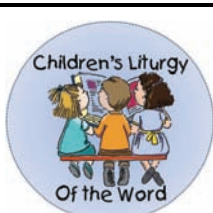

## DOCTRINAL CORNER

**Does my separation and civil divorce, prohibit me from receiving Holy Communion?**

*“Anyone who desires to receive Christ in Eucharist communion must be in the state of grace. Anyone aware of having sinned mortally must not receive communion without having received absolution in the sacrament of penance.”* (CCC:1415). If the divorced are remarried civilly, the Church maintains that the new union cannot be recognized as valid if the first marriage is valid: *“they cannot receive Eucharistic communion as long as this situation persists”*. (CCC: 1650).

**If I'm a non-Catholic, what procedures and protocols should I observe when I go to Mass?**

We ask that you respectfully observe the parish community at Mass, and that you follow along as the community prays, sings, reads, sits, stands, and exchanges greetings with one another in the presence of Jesus Christ.
