Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following the interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Saturday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be *baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.*

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with Msgr. Edgardo Pan, PH for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person.

Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults An interview with the Pastor is mandatory.

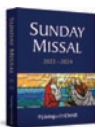

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Is missing Sunday Mass a mortal sin?

The requirement to attend Mass on Sunday and other holy days of obligation, rooted in the 3rd Commandment and codified in the Church law (*Code of Canon Law 1246-48*), is a serious obligation for all Catholics. A Catholic who: 1) is able to attend Sunday Mass (i.e., who is not impeded by illness, etc.), 2) knows the seriousness of this requirement, and 3) nonetheless freely chooses to miss Mass, thereby commits a mortal sin (*Catechism of the Catholic Church #2181*).

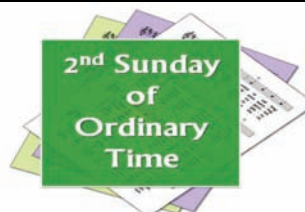

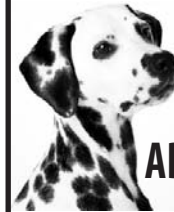
