Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

Why is St. Paul referred to as an apostle when clearly he was not one of the twelve?

An apostle is one who is sent forth. St. Paul was clearly sent forth by Jesus, entrusted with a mission. Paul refers to himself as an apostle many times in the New Testament, and even defends his apostleship in his first letter to the Corinthians (1 Cor. 9:1-2).

The Liturgy of the Word with Children (also known as children's liturgy) is looking for volunteers. We would like to see more male role models for the children.

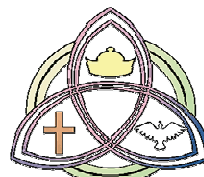
