Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following the interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Saturday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with Msgr. Edgardo Pan, PH for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person.

Yes. Such circumstances of themselves do not exclude the possibility of a Catholic funeral (*Code of Canon Law, c. 1184*). If any doubt occurs, consult the Office of Spiritual Affairs.

In the process of our hall kitchen renovation we experienced flooding in the kitchen area, especially this April. 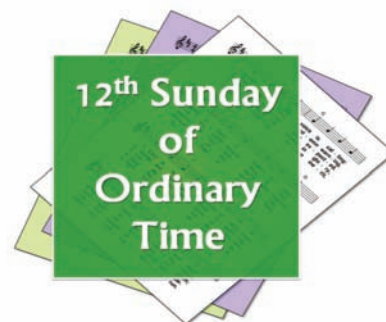


THE 2024 SUNDAY OFFERTORY ENVELOPES
