
DOCTRINAL CORNER

What is the difference between a Funeral Service and a Funeral Mass?

The <u>Holy Eucharist</u> is celebrated in a Funeral Mass, but not in a Funeral Service. A Funeral Mass is appropriate in many circumstances for a deceased baptized Catholic, except if the deceased rarely attended Mas or practiced the faith or publicly repudiated Catholicism.
