### I no longer want to be Catholic. Can I remove my name from the baptismal register?

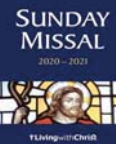
Baptismal Registers are records of historical fact. They are not archives of membership enrollment. Accordingly, a person's name can never be removed from a Baptismal Register after he or she has been Baptized. The only changes allowed are those necessary to correct errors originally transposed into the record. Should you wish to enquire further about this subject, please contact the Office of Spiritual Affairs.
