Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Is cremation allowed for Catholics and what are the rules governing on the burial of the remains?

The Church allows cremation, unless it is chosen for reasons contrary to Christian doctrine.

Cremated remains should be properly **buried/interred** and **NOT kept at home or divided among family members**. They should **NEVER be scattered** on the sea, from the air or on the ground or put inside lockets or jewelries.

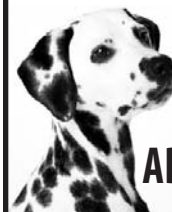
