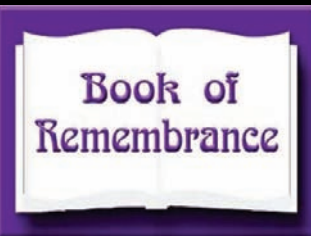

have passed away. Names that are in the book will be remembered in all of our masses in November.

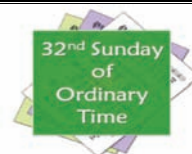

DOCTRINAL CORNER

May I receive Holy Eucharist on my tongue?

It is in the right of the communicants to decide whether they will receive the Eucharist in the hand, on the tongue, kneeling or standing. The norm of the Archdiocese of Toronto is to receive Holy Eucharist standing prefaced by a slight bow of the head (*cf. General Instruction of the Roman Missal, No. 160*).

Can I receive Holy Communion more than once a day?

Yes, but no more than twice in a 24-hour period: "One who has received the Blessed Sacrament may receive it again on the same day only within a Eucharistic celebration in which that person participates". (*Canon Law 17* (http://www.vatican.va/archive/ENG1104/___p39.HTM)).
