Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following the interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Saturday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with Msgr. Edgardo Pan, PH for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person.

SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL CHRISTMAS GIFT DRIVE 2022

While we are still a ways from the start of Advent (November 27th), due to the ongoing concerns about COVID-19, our Conference like many other organizations, has had to continue our amended approach to assisting our Neighbours In Need. As you might expect, there has been a heavier negative impact from COVID-19 on our client base than the general population. For your information, last Christmas we assisted 158 families including 477 adults and children with assistance totalling \$11,585 plus your generous gifts.

Since March 2020, we have only provided our clients with food vouchers by mail as we have tried to eliminate the risk to our clients and members, by avoiding all in-person visits. For this reason, **for Christmas 2022, we are again unable to deliver toys/gifts you have generously provided under the Angel Tree for many years.** Alternatively, we are appealing to you, our Parishioners, to provide Walmart or Shopper's Drug Mart gift cards which will allow parents to directly purchase small gifts for their children. While not ideal, it will allow mail-out along with a Christmas Food Voucher. If you are able to support our work this year, denominations of \$10 / \$20 / \$30 would be preferred so we could spread it out for expected demand this year. We will be doing our mail-out the first week of December to allow for usual Christmas mail delays, so if you are able to help, **please drop the gift cards off at the Church Office before December 6, 2022.**

In addition to the above, as fund raising is limited in this environment, we would gratefully accept monetary donations over this period via Poor Box envelopes, or via the special St. Vincent de Paul collection to be scheduled *for the weekend of November 19th/20th.*

Please accept our sincerest thank you in advance for thinking of the needy in our Parish Community over the upcoming Christmas Season.
