Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

Bundle Up for the Society of Saint Vincent de Paul



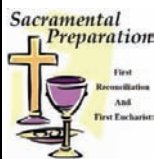

DOCTRINAL CORNER

Who may baptize?

The ordinary minister of Baptism is a Bishop, priest, or deacon. In the case of an emergency, any person may baptize, even if not baptized him/herself. This person must intend what the Church intends, and baptize the child with water, using the Trinitarian formula: "I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."



SOCIETY OF SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL CHRISTMAS GIFT DRIVE 2020

While we are still a ways from the start of Advent (November 29th), due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, our Conference like many other organizations, has had to amend our approach to assisting our Neighbours In Need. As you might expect and as the media has outlined, there has been a heavier negative impact from COVID-19 on our client base than the general population. For your information, last Christmas we assisted 181 families including 520 adults and children with assistance totaling \$15,675 plus your generous gifts.

This year since March we have only provided our clients with food vouchers by mail as we have tried to eliminate the risk to our clients and members, by avoiding all in-person visits. For this reason, **for Christmas 2020, we are unable to deliver toys/gifts you have generously provided under the Angel Tree for many years.** Alternatively, we are appealing to you, our Parishioners, to provide Walmart or Shopper's Drug Mart gift cards which will allow parents to directly purchase small gifts for their children. While not ideal, it will allow mail-out along with a Christmas Food Voucher. If you are able to support our work this year, denominations of \$5 / \$10 / \$25 would be preferred so we could spread it out for an expected larger demand this year. We will be doing our mail-out the first week of December to allow for usual Christmas mail delays, so if you are able to help, **please drop the gift cards off at the Church Office before December 2, 2020.**

In addition to the above, as fund raising is limited in this environment, we would gratefully accept monetary donations over this period via Poor Box envelopes, or via the special St. Vincent de Paul collection scheduled for the weekend of November 29th.

Please accept our sincerest thank you in advance for thinking of the needy in our Parish Community over the upcoming Christmas Season.
