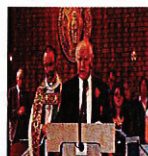
The Sanctuary Lamp (Church) was donated Manuela de Jesus Mangaran in loving memory of Felix de Jesus.

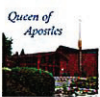

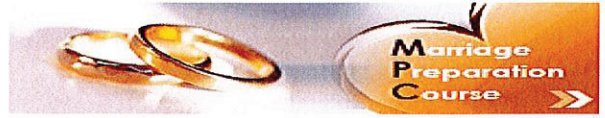
