Baptism Every 3rd and 4th Sundays of the month

An interview with the Pastor to set the baptism date is mandatory. Following this interview, attendance by the Parents and Catholic Godparents at Baptism Preparation Class, held every First Wednesday of the month, is required. Parents of the child to be baptized are expected to be active members of the Parish community.

Marriage One year notice is normally required to prepare to receive this sacrament. Please contact the Parish Office to schedule a meeting with Fr. Godofredo Claudio for an initial interview.

Pastoral Care of the Sick. Requests for visitation of the sick and/or to receive the sacraments for the sick and homebound are to be made through the Parish Office. In times of emergency or beyond regular office hours, please contact a Priest in person. If visitation is to be made at the Hospital, please contact the Call Centre at (416) 467-2927.

For Whom: Parent Parishioners of children 7 years of age or older, who regularly worship at St. Rose of Lima Church, and whose children attend the schools of St. Rose of Lima, St. Barbara, St. Richard, St. Victor, and, any other Catholic school. Parishioners whose child attends a public school are asked to call the Parish Office.

At the meeting, kindly provide us with a copy of the child's baptism certificate *in English*.



Confirmation: Information and Registration Session

**Saturday, October 17th, 2015 – 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., OR
Thursday, October 22nd, 2015 – 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. OR
Saturday, October 24th 2015 – 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.**
The meeting will take place in the Parish Hall.

For Whom: Parent Parishioners of Grade 7 and Grade 8 students at St. Rose of Lima, St. Barbara, St. Richard, and St. Victor Catholic Schools. Registration for this Sacrament is currently being conducted through schools. If your child attends a Catholic elementary school other than those mentioned, or, is already in high school, and, your family worships at this Parish, Parent Parishioners are requested to obtain a registration form at the Parish Office in mid- September.

Confirmation candidates and both parents MUST attend this session. On this date, a copy of the child's baptismal certificate (*in English*) must be submitted. As part of the preparations for this very important occasion, we encourage Parent Parishioners and the Confirmation Candidates to decide as to who will be your Sponsor. The Sponsor should be a Roman Catholic, and as part of the documentary requirement, a copy of his/her Baptismal and/or Confirmation certificates (*in English*) should be submitted as well.



R.C.I.A. Invitation to "INQUIRE"

"Inquiry" is a time to ask questions and seek information about the Catholic Church with the possibility of entering the process to become fully initiated into the Catholic Church. This time of inquiry is for adults who:

- Have never been baptized, or
- Who were baptized in another Christian Faith Tradition but are now interested in the Catholic Tradition, or
- An adult who was baptized Catholic but never learned about or practiced the Catholic faith, and perhaps never received the sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
