For Whom: Parent Parishioners of Grade 7 and Grade 8 students at St. Rose of Lima, St. Barbara, St. Richard, and St. Victor Catholic Schools. Registration for this Sacrament is currently being conducted through schools. If your child attends a Catholic elementary school other than those mentioned, or, is already in high school, and, your family worships at this Parish, Parent Parishioners are requested to obtain a registration form at the Parish Office in mid-September.

Confirmation candidates and both parents MUST attend this session. On this date, a copy of the child's baptismal certificate (in English) must be submitted. The Sponsor should be a Roman Catholic, and as part of the documentary requirement, a copy of his/her Baptismal and/or Confirmation certificates (in English) should be submitted as well.



R.C.I.A. Invitation to "INQUIRE"

"Inquiry" is a time to ask questions and seek information about the Catholic Church with the possibility of entering the process to become fully initiated into the Catholic Church. This time of inquiry is for adults who:

- Have never been baptized, or
- Who were baptized in another Christian Faith Tradition but are now interested in the Catholic Tradition, or
- An adult who was baptized Catholic but never learned about or practiced the Catholic faith, and perhaps never received the sacraments of Eucharist and/or Confirmation.
