



Thursday, October  $15^{th}$ , 2015 - 6:00 – 8:00 p.m., OR Saturday, October  $17^{th}$ , 2015 - 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. The meeting will take place in the Parish Hall.

**For Whom:** Parent Parishioners of children 7 years of age or older, who regularly worship at St. Rose of Lima Church, and whose children attend the schools of St. Rose of Lima, St. Barbara, St. Richard, St. Victor, and, any other Catholic school. Parishioners whose child attends a public school are asked to call the Parish Office.

### Confirmation: Information and Registration Session

Saturday, October  $17^{th}$ , 2015 - 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., OR Thursday, October  $22^{nd}$ , 2015 - 6:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. OR Saturday, October  $24^{th}$  2015 - 1:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. The meeting will take place in the Parish Hall.

**For Whom:** Parent Parishioners of Grade 7 and Grade 8 students at St. Rose of Lima, St. Barbara, St. Richard, and St. Victor Catholic Schools. Registration for this Sacrament is currently being conducted through schools. If your child attends a Catholic elementary school other than those mentioned, or, is already in high school, and, your family worships at this Parish, Parent Parishioners are requested to obtain a registration form at the Parish Office in mid-September.

Confirmation candidates and both parents MUST attend this session. On this date, a copy of the child's baptismal certificate *(in English)* must be submitted. As part of the preparations for this very important occasion, we encourage Parent Parishioners and the Confirmation Candidates to decide as to who will be your Sponsor. The Sponsor should be a Roman Catholic, and as part of the documentary requirement, a copy of his/her Baptismal and/or Confirmation certificates *(in English)* should be submitted as well.
