It may surprise many Canadian Catholics, but some of the poorest and neediest missions served by the Church can be found here in Canada. These are mainly poor and scattered communities in the Canadian North, isolated from their neighbors because of geography and the extreme cold of the long winter season. These are missions where families constantly struggle to cover the basics such as food and shelter and clothing because opportunities for work and jobs are scarce.

**On Sunday, August 19,** there will be a special collection, at all Sunday Masses, for the Catholic Missions in Canada and the Scarboro Foreign Missions. *Please make use of the envelopes in this week's bulletin, and please be generous.*

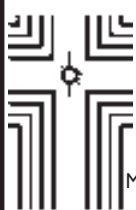
