

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

Why was there a special Latin Mass in honour of St Vincent de Paul on July 19 at 8pm? July 19 was the date of St Vincent de Paul's feast from the time of his canonization in 1737 until 1970. Originally, when he was beatified, the date of his death was the feast day (September 27). But, like St Vincent, the priests founded by St Vincent (Vincentians or Lazarists) ran seminaries for training future priests. In France in the 18th century, September was a month of vacation for the seminarians! Celebrating St Vincent's feast on September 27 meant that the seminaries dedicated to St Vincent could not keep his feast with much solemnity, as all the seminarians were away. As they did not want to make them come back so early, they petitioned the Pope to move the feast to a free liturgical day in July. In July, the seminarians were still at the seminary. Thus, the Vincentians/Lazarists started having two days to honour St Vincent! His September 27th date reminds us of his love for the poor. The July 19th feast reminds us of the love St Vincent had for the priesthood.

On July 19, 1924, our parish celebrated the first feast of St Vincent in our upper church. On the 100th anniversary of that first Mass of St Vincent, we wanted to celebrate a Mass in Latin as they did 100 years ago. Many thanks to those who attended. Many thanks to Ed's Ice Cream for hosting us after the Mass.

Just in time for first vespers of St Vincent, we had a gift of flowers for his statue. But we also got a gift of flower boxes for the front railing from Willem & Jools on Roncesvalles. These flowers are a sign that not only the Lord is alive, but St Vincent de Paul is also alive and active in heaven. St Vincent is the heavenly patron of all those in misery. His fatherly heart is open to all!
