



On the altar at the left side of our church, we have a statue of Christ. He blesses us with his right hand. His left-hand gestures towards his heart. On his chest, we see his heart, with flames of fire on top of his heart.

Last Friday was the Solemnity of the Sacred Heart. Christ wants us to know that everything he did on earth was motivated by one reason: Love. He loves his eternal Father and always does the will of His Father. But he also loves all those His Father gave him. He loves, even likes, each one of us. He enjoys being around us. He burns with love to give his love and mercy to us.

In the 16th century, when people were so focused on the justice of God and our need to be perfect in order to be first loved by God, Christ began to show himself with his heart in his hands. Our church is a place where Christ pours out his love and mercy on us. When we see this statue, let us say with St Mother Teresa: "Jesus, I believe in your tender love for me."
