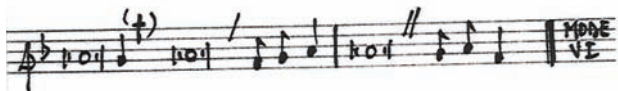

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

One of the tremendous features of our church is the proportion between the windows and the church. Notice how the five windows in the sanctuary fit very well the size of our church. Among those five windows representing the five wounds of Christ, the central window above the altar is especially striking. Christ is on the Cross surrounded by his Mother and the disciple whom he loved.

Every time we see this window we are supposed to remember that Our Lord died for us. But we also are meant to remember that the unnamed beloved disciple represents you and me. We too are supposed to stand by the Cross of Christ and offer Jesus to the Father. With Jesus, we are able to offer ourselves to the Father. When the priest lifts up the Body and Blood of Christ at Mass, when he says, through Him and with Him and in Him, we are meant to join ourselves to Christ and offer our lives and each day to God.

In that most solemn moment of the Mass, Mary is with us. She is holding Christ and his beloved Body, the Church. The Blessed Virgin is not only the Mother of Jesus. She is also the spiritual Mother of all his beloved disciples. When Christ was about to die, he looked at his beloved disciple, he said, “Behold your Mother.”

What Our Lord said to the beloved disciple, he says to all of us. On this weekend, at the Mass, let us ask for the grace to discover more deeply that Mary is our Mother. Let us thank her for being a mother to us!
