

MARY, MOTHER OF THE CHURCH

In 2018, Pope Francis decreed that the Monday after Pentecost be celebrated as the memorial of Mary, Mother of Church.

The decree establishing the memorial was published March 3, 2018 in a letter from Cardinal Robert Sarah, head of the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments.

As Cardinal Sarah explained, Pope Francis added the memorial to the Roman Calendar after carefully considering how the promotion of devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary under this particular title might encourage growth in "the maternal sense of the Church" and in "genuine Marian piety."

100TH ANNIVERSARY CORNER

Why does the Church have Old Testament symbols on the ceiling? In particular, why do we have symbols of the Ten Commandments, the two stone tablets? The Ten Commandments were given in the desert at Mount Sinai with great noise and flames of fire. The Jews remember the gift of the Law on the feast of Pentecost.

On that Jewish feast, hundreds of thousands of people were gathered in Jerusalem fifty days after Jesus rose from the dead. The Apostles were gathered in prayer and friendship with Mary, and about 100 other followers of Christ. They were praying for the Holy Spirit. Around 10 in the morning, the Holy Spirit descended upon the Church in tongues of fire and a mighty wind. The scene reminded people of the first Pentecost when the Law was given to Moses. But instead of causing fear, this new gift of the new Law, caused divine love to overflow. The Apostles were transformed by the Holy Spirit into saintly men. Filled with the Holy Spirit's charisms, they proclaimed to the gathered crowds the mighty works of God.

Every time we see the image of the Ten Commandments on our ceiling above the altar rail, we are supposed to remember what the Holy Spirit can do for us. The Holy Spirit is the new Law, the new personal guide for our lives. God no longer simply guides us from the outside by his Law. He enters our hearts and pours divine love into every aspect of our lives. The Holy Spirit enables us to keep the Ten Commandments. These commandments are no longer burdensome for us. In fact, the Holy Spirit can give us joy and peace in following the commandments.
