A Message from Fr. Rob:

Every three years, we are treated to a reading from St. John's Gospel Chapter 6 known as the Bread of Life Discourse. In this chapter St. John reveals the teaching of Jesus on the Eucharist, starting with the feeding of the 5000 and then gradually helping the crowds to understand that Jesus is revealing Himself as food for the journey, the Bread of Life. We are invited to reflect on the Eucharist as the centre of our spiritual life. Each week as we gather around the Lord's Table, we are nourished with the Eucharist so that we can grow in holiness and have what we need to be missionary disciples in our world.

As we listen and pray over these weeks, let us ask for a deeper love of the Eucharist. Interesting how in the United States, they have embarked upon a Eucharistic revival. Shocked by the number of Catholics who do not understand or believe in the Real Presence of Jesus, the whole country is in a time of prayer and reflection on why this gift is so essential. Let us embrace the call as well to understand and know the Lord as He comes to us in His Body and Blood. Join us on August 2nd, the first Friday of the month for a time of prayer before the Blessed Sacrament following the 9 am mass at OLA until benediction at 11 am.



LITURGICAL TEACHING: SUNDAY MASS

Points to remember to avoid any confusion. Experts tell us we need to hear the message at least 7 times before it sinks in!

1. When the priest has finished the washing of his hands and turns towards altar, all stand and join "Pray sisters and brothers...."
2. All kneel during the Eucharistic prayer. Following the Great Amen, all stand for Our Father, sign of peace and Lamb of God. After the Lamb of God, all kneel during the invitation: Behold the Lamb of God....
3. **Once** the priest has received communion, **all stand** and remain standing until the last person in the communion procession has received. Approaching the communion minister, we bow our heads as a sign of reverence to the Eucharist.
4. Once the last person in the communion line has received, all may kneel or be seated. We do not wait until the Eucharist has been put into the tabernacle.
