A Message from Fr. Rob:

When we are baptized, we embrace the threefold mission of Christ as Priest, Prophet and King. That means we are called to embrace a life of holiness, to proclaim the truth of the Gospel at all times and to imitate the example of the Good Shepherd. Our readings over the next couple weekends speak to us of our prophetic role in the world. Not an easy task to be sure. When we see the example of the prophets in the Old Testament, many if not all faced rejection, persecution and hardship as they went about calling the people of Israel to a life of holiness. Jesus faced rejection, even in his own hometown. And He warned the apostles that they would be persecuted on account of Him.

St. Paul when thinking about his own trials recognized the presence of God that accompanied him throughout his ministry: "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness." As we answer the call to preach the Gospel, let us rejoice in the gifts of the Spirit that strengthen us to do the Lord's work.

PASTORAL PLANNING


June has ended and hopefully the summer will bring times of rest and peace. However it is also the time when the pastoral team engages in our work of planning for the next 12 months. LITURGICAL TEACHING: SUNDAY MASS

Points to remember to avoid any confusion. Experts tell us we need to hear the message at least 7 times before it sinks in!

1. When the priest has finished the washing of his hands and turns towards altar, all stand and join "Pray sisters and brothers...."
2. All kneel during the Eucharistic prayer. Following the Great Amen, all stand for Our Father, sign of peace and Lamb of God. After the Lamb of God, all kneel during the invitation: Behold the Lamb of God....
3. **Once** the priest has received communion, **all stand** and remain standing until the last person in the communion procession has received. Approaching the communion minister, we bow our heads as a sign of reverence to the Eucharist.
4. Once the last person in the communion line has received, all may kneel or be seated. We do not wait until the Eucharist has been put into the tabernacle.
