LITURGICAL TEACHING: SUNDAY MASS

Points to remember.

- 1. When the priest has finished the washing of his hands and turns towards altar, all stand and join "Pray sisters and brothers...."
- 2. All kneel during the Eucharistic prayer. Following the Great Amen, all stand for Our Father, sign of peace and Lamb of God. After the Lamb of God, all kneel during the invitation: Behold the Lamb of God....
- 3. **Once** the priest has received communion, all stand and remain standing until the last person in the communion procession has received. Approaching the communion minister, we bow our heads as a sign of reverence to the Eucharist.
- 4. Once the last person has received, all may kneel or be seated. We do not wait until the Eucharist has been put into the tabernacle.


