## Sunday, June 30, 2024 Thirteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time

### A Message from Fr. Rob:

What lessons we can learn when we open our hearts to God's message in the Gospel. Today we encounter two people of faith. They are included in the Gospel because of their trust in Jesus. Jairus comes to Jesus to ask him to help his little girl who is sick. He knows that Jesus is the one to turn to in his time of need. The woman, who has been suffering for years, wants only to touch the hem of Jesus' robe. She does not want to draw attention to herself in such a crowd but also perhaps feels unworthy that Jesus would want to help her.

Do we sometimes feel like that? Is there something keeping us from standing up straight and tall in front of the Lord with our need for healing and peace? The Lord wants to heal and strengthen us. She doesn't have a name. Maybe she represents all of us who carry burdens and who suffer and long for wholeness. Both of these figures show us that the way to healing is to call on the name of Jesus. In the summer days ahead, let us approach the Lord with confidence and boldness so that we might encounter His love.

### LITURGICAL TEACHING: SUNDAY MASS

Points to remember to avoid any confusion.

- 1. When the priest has finished the washing of his hands and turns towards altar, all stand and join "Pray sisters and brothers...."
- 2. All kneel during the Eucharistic prayer. Following the Great Amen, all stand for Our Father, sign of peace and Lamb of God. After the Lamb of God, all kneel during the invitation: Behold the Lamb of God....
- 3. Once the priest has received communion, all stand and remain standing until the last person in the communion procession has received. Approaching the communion minister, we bow our heads as a sign of reverence to the Eucharist.
- 4. Once the last person has received, all may kneel or be seated. We do not wait until the Eucharist has been put into the tabernacle.


