BUILDING UPDATE: PARKING LOT PROJECTS

We have received permission last week from the Diocese to move forward with the parking lot remediation at both sites. We are working with a consultant and have begun the process of preparing the documents outlining the scope of work so that we can get contractors prepared to submit their bids.

We will be coming up with plans once the documents are ready, determining the length of time for the projects, what contingencies we will need to prepare for and what alternate worship plans we will need depending upon the scope of the project and how accessible or inaccessible the sites will be. Luckily, we are a family and said contingency plans may revolve around a shut down of the site during the week and most likely a weekend so that they can complete the work in a timely fashion. In that case, a mass schedule will be created for the affected weekend using one site for the masses while the other is inaccessible and then doing the same when the other project gets started. Clearly without a functioning parking lot, there is not enough street parking to accommodate everyone at either site. It is a work in progress at the moment as we figure out timelines etc. but we wanted everyone to prepare themselves for some inconvenience so that we can get these parking lots back to top condition. Remember there are two seasons: winter and construction!
