

D-Day 1944 ... Lest We Forget



We remember D-Day, June 6, 1944. This was the beginning of the Allied invasion of Northwest Europe in World War II. This photo is entitled Canadian soldiers wait to land on HMCS Prince David off the Normandy beachhead on D-Day. Approximately 14.000 Canadians landed in

Normandy, about 450 jumped by parachute or landed by glider, and around 10,000 sailors of the RCN participated. Estimates vary, but there were over 1000 Canadian casualties, with more than 400 killed. May we never forget the sacrifices of our veterans... and we remember those who continue to serve our country.

Construction Updates

The flat roof at the side entrance of the parish hall was replaced last week by Noble Roofing. It is now properly sloped, with custom-made beveled insulation. There should be no more water build-up on the roof, or damage to the stucco walls. We need to get some repairs done to the stucco during the summer. We also had five of our exterior cameras replaced. The newer cameras have a wider lens and have glass lenses, as opposed to plastic (which have a tendency to fade over time). These were covered by a grant from the Ontario Government under the Hate Crimes Act. This grant also covered the cost of new exterior lighting.

With your generosity on the occasion of my 25th Anniversary of Ordination (\$9000), we will be purchasing AED's for our church and parish hall/gymnasium. There are many types of AED's out there, so we are going to get ones with the latest technology, longest battery life and best warranty and security. We will also purchase new First Aid Kits for the church, office and parish hall. Many thanks for your generosity!


