Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 14: 12-16, 22-26)

## SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

Also know as *Corpus Christi*, this feast honors Jesus Christ, Really, Truly and Substantially Present under the appearances of bread and wine. This Presence happens through the change which the Church calls transubstantiation ("change of substance"), when at the Consecration of the Mass, the priest says the words which Christ Himself pronounced over bread and wine, "This is My Body," "This is the chalice of My Blood," "Do this in remembrance of Me." (*EWTN*)

Benedict XVI: "The Feast of Corpus Christi is inseparable from Holy Thursday ... Whereas on the evening of Holy Thursday we relive the mystery of Christ who offers himself to us ... today ... this same mystery is proposed for the adoration and meditation ... and the Blessed Sacrament is carried in procession ... to show that the Risen Christ walks in our midst ..."

## Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus Friday, June 7<sup>th</sup> - Mass at 8 am; Adoration 8:30am to 9am

"This feast reminds us of the mystery of the love of God for the people of all times" (St. John Paul II).

The Feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus dates back to the 11th century. The devotion was embraced by mystics such as St. Bernard of Clairvaux and Gertrude of Helfta. In 1673, Margaret Mary Alacoque received a vision of Jesus' compassionate heart, pierced by the sins of the world, which gave impetus to the devotion. Pope Leo XIII explained the Sacred Heart as both, "a symbol and living image of the infinite love of Christ." (*Divine Office*)
