Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 3:20-35)



In the Gospel Jesus speaks about an unforgiveable sin. What is that?

God's forgiveness is a gift freely given to us, an expression of God's love. But if we won't open to receive it, then God cannot impose His love on anyone since love is freely given and received. In effect, a refusal of God's forgiveness is a rejection of God's love. Thus, the unforgiveable sin is refusal to accept God's forgiveness. It is unforgivable not because God does not want to forgive, but because the person doesn't want to be forgiven.
