FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 7:1-8,14-15,21-23)



The Gospel shows that religion goes deeper than rituals and practices. The people in the Gospel kept the religious law, but their worship was no more than lip service. So, quoting Isaiah, Jesus says, "**This people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me**." St. James, in the second reading, teaches that "*pure and undefiled*" religion is to care for those who are most vulnerable and in need (James 1:27).

Today's Liturgy of the Word emphasizes that true religion is expressed in both, religious practices and taking care of those around us.
