# FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Weekly Gospel Reflection (Mk 7:31-37)



As we are told, "looking up to heaven, Jesus sighed and said to a deaf man, 'Be opened'" (Mk 7:34). That sigh coming out of Jesus at the moment of healing the deafmute man reveals deep truth about God's care for us. To say, 'Jesus sighed' is to say that God is deeply moved by our sufferings and needs, whatever they are.

The Church has always seen in the seemingly strange way Jesus heals the deaf-mute man (he puts his fingers into his ears and touches his tongue) a symbol of the sacraments by which Christ still "touches" heals our hearts.
