Other healing Masses in which non-sacramental oil (olive oil) can be used for Masses with the “slain of the spirit” or other “healing Masses” which express our need for healing should be differentiated from the Mass with anointing of the sick.

**2)** Kendra Oatway, baptized in another Christian Church, wishes to become a Catholic. She has journeyed with our community for some time. She has been dismissed regularly at the 11:30 am Masses to reflect on the Word of God with a Catechist.
