**2024 ENVELOPE BOXES** are available at the back of the church for pickup. **Please note that if you used an envelope box in 2023, the same number has been given to you for 2024.** The only exception is if you had a box number over 375 in 2023, you have been assigned a new number just under 375 for 2024. All boxes are labelled, so please cross reference your name and address to ensure you pick up the correct box. **These box numbers have been assigned for tax purposes, so it is important that you take the correct box.** There are also blank envelopes at the entrances to the churches to pick up and use if you did not have a box number in 2023.

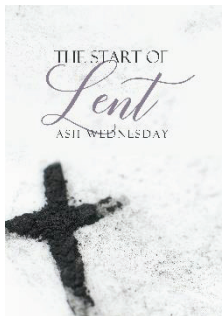
Here are a few tips to make sure your contributions are accurately recorded:

- 1) **As of January 1, 2024, please discard any envelopes from previous years.**
- 2) **For the first few contributions of the year, please clearly print your name/address on the envelope, as well as the amount of the donation.** After that, please print your name and donation amount. Thank you for your continued support!

**TAX RECEIPTS for 2023 will be ready for pickup at the front of the church to the right of the entrance, next weekend, February 17/18th.** Please ensure you pick up the correct receipt by cross referencing your name and address.

**THE WAY OF THE CROSS:** Members of our Knights of Columbus and Catholic Women's League will lead The Way of the Cross **every Tuesday during the Lenten season starting from February 20<sup>th</sup> to and including March 29<sup>th</sup>** immediately after the 9:00am Mass. Everyone is encouraged to join us.

**SENIORS/YOUNG AT HEART CARD/GAME GROUP:** Please note our Seniors/Young at Heart Group will meet on **the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday (February 7<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup>) in February from 1-3 p.m.** due to Ash Wednesday. It will return to the usual schedule in March.



**ASH WEDNESDAY** begins the penitential season of Lent. This year it falls **on Wed., Feb. 14<sup>th</sup>** (yes, Valentine's Day!). We will have masses, with distribution of ashes, at 9:00am, 4:30pm and 7:00pm. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. Fasting applies to Roman Catholics from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning

abstinence from meat are binding upon all Roman Catholics from age 14 onwards.

**PAUPER'S SUPPER ASH WEDNESDAY** – Please join us for our annual Ash Wednesday Pauper's Supper in the parish hall on **February 14<sup>th</sup> following the 4:30pm Mass.** The Ladies of Fatima serve a simple but hearty meal of homemade soup and rolls to begin the Lenten fasting season. (This year Ash Wednesday falls on February 14 – so bring your sweetheart). This simple, delicious meal offers a time of reflection and fellowship as we enter one of the holiest times in the church calendar. **Please join us between 5pm and 7pm.** Good will donations gratefully accepted.
