LENT: Lent begins this Wednesday. Here are the Church regulations for fasting and abstinence during Lent: Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fasting and abstinence. All Fridays in Lent are days of abstinence. Everyone 14 years of age or older is bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent and Good Friday. Everyone 18 or older, and under 60 years of age, is bound to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. It is considered fasting if in a day you only have one full meal and two other meals that combined do not equal a full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted. When health or ability to work would be seriously affected, the law does not oblige.

WAY OF THE CROSS: Every Wednesday during Lent, immediately after the morning Mass, our Knights of Columbus and our Catholic Women's League members will follow the Way of the Cross. The only exception will be the first one, which will take place on Thursday, February 23rd because Ash Wednesday is a busy morning with the distribution of ashes after Mass. We ask all parishioners to remain in Church and join us on this journey.
