- 1) **Presentation of the Lord.**
The Presentation of the Lord is an occasion to celebrate those who consecrate their lives to the Lord, particularly the counter-cultural vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. Many among the faithful followers of Christ also live in this spirit, knowing that all of us are challenged to consecrate ourselves to God.
- 2) Archbishop Terrence Prendergast, S.J. will be here to celebrate Confirmation for our parish children who are mostly in and around grade 6 on Saturday, February 8th during the 4:30pm Mass. I ask parish families to continue to give them our prayerful support.
- 3) A reminder to parents who are preparing their children for the initiation sacraments of Confirmation and First Communion to bring their children to Church for worship. Sacraments are meaningful encounters with Christ who calls us to gather and render praise and thanks to God.
- 4) With the assistance of a Knight of Columbus member who is a structural engineer, we are revisiting the possibility of renovating our Parish Hall at a reasonable cost. We shall have more storage space, upgraded and accessible washroom facilities and other improvements in the parish hall. We shall provide you with further information as it becomes available.
- 5) In light of the upcoming LRT project in the near future, we have consulted with a structural engineer. He will work closely with our Finance Council to discuss preparing an analysis immediately before and after the project, so as to ensure no possible structural damage to our church buildings.
- 6) Our next Adult Faith Session is on Thursday, February 13. We will continue our reflection on the Church and our missionary discipleship.
- 7) Prayers for vocation for the Presentation of the Lord – World Day of Prayer for Consecrated Life: For those called to service for the Lord as priests, sisters and brothers, that they will be encouraged to follow the Lord and faithful to His choice of them, we pray to the Lord.
