2024 ENVELOPE BOXES are available at the back of the church
 for pickup. **Please note that if you used an envelope box in
 2023, the same number has been given to you for 2024.** The
 only exception is if you had a box number over 375 in 2023,
**you have been assigned a new number just under 375 for
 2024.** All boxes are labelled, so please cross reference your
 name and address to ensure you pick up the correct box. **These
 box numbers have been assigned for tax purposes, so it is
 important that you take the correct box.** There are also blank
 envelopes at the entrances to the churches to pick up and use if
 you did not have a box number in 2023.

- 1) **As of January 1, 2024, please discard any envelopes from
 previous years.**
- 2) **For the first few contributions of the year, please clearly
 print your name/address on the envelope, as well as the
