ASH WEDNESDAY- FEBRUARY 14, 2018 – Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. The law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age; the law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older. Penance is considered to be an important requirement of Christian life. It is intended to open our hearts to God and others and to be a means of purification and spiritual liberation and a witness to the depth of our faith. **The Way of the Cross will be prayed at 8:00am. Ashes will be distributed at the 9:00am, 4:30pm and 7:00pm Masses. Please note that on Ash Wednesday, February 14th, there will be a 7:00pm Mass.**

PAUPER SUPPER –Please mark your calendar and join us at our annual Pauper Supper of bread and homemade soup **Wednesday, February 14th, 5:00pm to 7:00pm in the Parish Hall.** Every year on Ash Wednesday the Ladies of Fatima brew up the best soup and serve it with plain bread and rolls to mark the start of our Lenten fasting season. 1) How do we live our missionary discipleship? The Gospel of last weekend calls us to be prophets, one of the threefold baptismal anointings (priest, prophet & king) that we received, to share actively in the mission and ministry of Jesus as our way into the kingdom. We are thankful that many of our parishioners heed this call, and we need many others to come forward to be of service in building up the Church (the Body of Christ). Perhaps we can make a resolution to be actively engaged at the early days of this year and the threshold of the Lenten Season.

2) Exercising our missionary discipleship when it comes to adults seeking initiation sacraments: as a few of our inquiries are ready shortly for the Rite of Acceptance as Catechumens, it is vitally important for the Christian Community to give prayerful support to them. We welcome them to continue worshipping with us by preparing them to be fed by the Gospel. They will be dismissed after the Liturgy of the Word to further reflect how the Gospel touches upon their lives.

3) LITURGY MOMENT – We have purchased Celebrate in Song Hymnals for use at worship. The hymnals have great liturgical hymns as well as different Mass settings. It should help us to lift up our voices and hearts in giving praise and thanksgiving to God at worship! At the 4:30 pm Mass we use the Guimont version of the Gloria (4.4, p. 60), and at the Sunday morning Masses, the Dawson version of the Gloria (3.2, p. 48) is used. This will enable parishioners to raise their voices and sing during worship!

4) Our community includes many elderly parishioners. We shall do our best to inform parishioners whenever there is a death in the parish family. We encourage you to come and give support and consolation to the family whenever there is a funeral, as the choir and altar servers do showing their support and prayers. As community-building is vitally important in a faith community, we shall make a concerted effort to inform you.

Our Lady of Fatima Parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, seeks to fulfill the call of Jesus to “come follow me,” to be true worshippers of the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit, and to love one another as Christ has loved us.
