MASS INTENTION STIPENDS: As of January 1, 2023 the Archdiocese has established that the stipends for both Announced and Unannounced Mass intentions will be the

same; at \$15. This represents no change in the offering for an Announced Mass but is an increase of \$5 for an Unannounced Mass. With an Announced Mass the intention for which the priest has been requested to offer the Mass is given a specific date and time that is then published in the bulletin. With an Unannounced Mass the intention is not given a specific date or time and is not published in the bulletin. Unannounced Mass Intentions are usually sent to missionary or retired priests to offer.

CHILDREN'S LITURGY: Children's Liturgy resumed January 8th at the 11:30am Mass. All children are welcome. No need to register; children come forward when invited. A parent is welcome to attend with their young ones. We are still in need of volunteers. Using our envelopes ensures you will receive a tax receipt. **To make sure your contributions are accurately recorded:** 1) As of Jan. 1, 2023, please discard any envelopes from previous years. 2) For the first few contributions of the year, please clearly print your name/address on the envelope, as well as the amount of the donation. After that, please print your name and the donation amount. Better yet, attach a pre-printed address label if you have them! Thank you for your continued support.

GENTLE REMINDER: Now that we are into the winter season with all its slush and snow, we ask parishioners to refrain as much as possible from placing boots on the kneelers during Mass, and instead to keep kneelers lifted up until needed. This will help prolong the life of the kneeler pads and reduce our cleaning costs and time throughout the winter season. In

addition, we ask parents to remind little ones not to dispose of chewing gum on the church pews, but instead to place gum in garbage receptacles prior to Mass. Thanks to everyone for helping to keep our church clean and reduce our overall cleaning costs and time.
