POPE FRANCIS ESTABLISHES WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY:

“I am with you always” (cf. Mt 28:20). Pope Francis has decided to institute a Church-wide celebration of a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. The theme’s purpose is to convey the closeness of God and the Church to the elderly and also to emphasize the intergenerational closeness between the young and the elderly. Starting this year, the day will be held on the fourth Sunday of July (**July 25, 2021**), close to the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. 1) Reflection for the 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 10-11): Jesus sends the twelve to engage in the ministry of transforming lives and helps them to witness as prophets. He symbolizes the missionary outreach of God’s presence in the world. It is this change of orientation or repentance for all those drawn to follow Christ which proclaims God’s ongoing commitment to the world.

2) Reflection for the 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time (July 17-18): “Woe to the shepherds who destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture” - Jeremiah’s warning words as mouthpiece of God to chastise shepherds in sheep’s clothing. In the Gospel, Jesus exemplifies the Good Shepherd who tends the sheep and exercises compassion for God’s people. He is the foundation of our hope!

3) Vaccine update: As the availability of vaccines is constantly changing and increasing thankfully, the number of those who are eligible to receive a second dose of vaccine accelerated. For further details regarding your eligibility for a second dose, please refer to ottawapublichealth.ca.

4) As of June 30, the province has allowed more attendance in Church while giving greater opening to indoor gatherings. The situation improves as a result of increased vaccinations and fewer cases of COVID. We await step 3 to begin around July 20th with the decreasing COVID –19 cases in Ottawa.

5) We are live-streaming Mass every Saturday at 4:30pm. You can participate virtually by going to the parish website and clicking the red button to access the Mass live, or to view the recording afterwards.

6) I announced my retirement from active full-time ministry as of the end of July with a farewell message at all Masses the weekend of June 12-13. For safety reasons, no reception will be held. Please check the website under Pastor’s message to read my farewell message! I would like to offer my gratitude to all those who offer kind words of appreciation during my stay here at Our Lady of Fatima.

7) Fr. Lindsay Harrison, current Pastor of St. John the Apostle Parish, will begin his ministry here as of August 1. He will be assisted by Fr. Dan Van Delst, Chancellor of the Diocese.
