**IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT
REGARDING BYRON CLOSURE**

Mark Taylor, Deputy Mayor and Councillor for Bay Ward, accepted our Parish's invitation to participate in a community meeting to discuss the closure of Byron Avenue to motor vehicles from Woodroffe to Lockhart. The meeting took place on Thursday, June 8th with more than 80 parishioners attending. Deputy Mayor Taylor confirmed that the decision, made in late January, is final. Feedback from the meeting and from parishioners who were unable to attend is being reviewed and a joint meeting of the Pastoral Council and the Finance Council was held on June 14th to develop a recommendation of an acceptable option to the Archdiocese and provide a formal response to the City of Ottawa. 1) Our parish welcomes all who are unbaptized or baptized in another Christian church and seek full communion with the Catholic Church. Please inform me and we shall begin the process without delay! According to the Order of the Christian Initiation of Adults, initiating new Catholic Christians is the responsibility of all the baptized. Rites are celebrating within the context of the worshipping faith community.

2) During our parish Masses, including the weekday Masses, our focus is on the Ambo (Real Presence of Christ in the Word of God proclaimed), the Altar (Bread and Wine transformed into the Body and Blood of Christ) and the Presider (who presides over the assembly in the person of Christ). Additional symbols such as statues do not belong at the sanctuary worship space, as noble as they are! This applies also at the Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, any addition to it merely serves as distraction from the primary focus!

3) Weddings and funerals model upon Sunday Mass, which always express our praise and thanksgiving for God's mighty deeds, particularly with the sacrifice of Christ, our One mediator. On Sundays, the lectors are vehicles through whom the living Word of God is made present to the congregation. Just as we do not announce the names of those who proclaim the Word on Sunday, by the same token, we do not name the individuals who proclaim the Word at weddings and funerals. Funeral Mass is not a celebration of the (past) life of the deceased, but we celebrate the life of the risen Christ, and the deceased shares in His death and Resurrection. In the same way, a wedding liturgy is a celebration of the mystery of God's love revealed in Christ, in whose love the couple seal a lifelong covenant of fidelity. Hence, liturgical music expresses our belief in God's loving mercy, whether at funerals or weddings. That is why secular music does not belong in wedding and funeral liturgies.

4) We give thanks to God for the ministry of Father Tavis Goski in our parish this past year and we wish him our very best and God's abounding blessings upon him as he embarks upon his new challenge of serving the community of Divine Infant in Orleans. We are not sure if there might be a priest doing graduate studies at a local university coming to assist here. If we cannot secure a priest-helper, we shall have to make necessary changes accordingly, in consultation with the Parish Council.

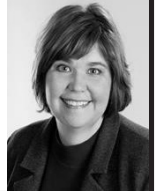

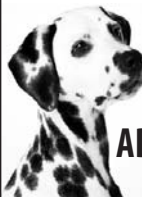

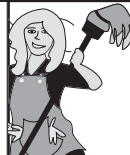
