1) We are now back to Ordinary Time with the Feast of the Holy Trinity last Sunday and the Body and Blood of Christ this Sunday. These two



feasts are closely connected with God's saving love for us. Holy Trinity: the love of God in communion of Father, Son and Holy Spirit, the outflow of divine love in order to save us and draw us up to share divine life. The Body and Blood of Christ expresses the giving of Christ himself for the life of the world, so that when we receive His Body and Blood, we pledge our commitment to be nourished and strengthened by him, and in turn, **be Bread broken for others and Blood poured out for others – our missionary discipleship.**

2) We celebrated the Rite of Welcoming for Kendra Oatway last Sunday at the 11:30am Mass. She was baptized in another Christian Church and wishes to become a Catholic Christian. At her baptism she already became part of the priestly people, our task is now to engage her to take part in the Liturgy of the Word: to discern the Word of God in her life as she prepares for profession of faith, confirmation and first communion as a Catholic. Our catechumens: Celia, Samantha and Emily continue to be dismissed from the assembly during the eucharist so that they can be fed by the living Word. In the event that some wonder why we involve the community in the initiation process of a few catechumens, the rationale is the same as to why we baptize infants at Mass. If we believe that baptism is the most important sacrament, because it is the entry into Christian life and discipleship, we cannot relegate it to Sunday afternoon when no one in the parish community is there. One can hardly imagine that we have an ordination to priesthood or diaconate on Sunday afternoon after Mass! Indeed, we exercise our discipleship by our prayerful support to families which bring their child for baptism at Sunday Mass. "If we situate these rites and sacraments of initiation where we have always situated eucharist – in the community on Sundays and feasts when it gathers to hear the word – then well-prepared homilies that are faithful to the astounding love, mercy and acceptance of the God of the covenant and that invite not only catechumens but the entire community to re-sound that word in their lives and hearts might become a transforming experience for the whole parish." (Echoing God's Word, by James Dunning, 1993).

3) We have available in the parish library two copies of an important book on Adult Initiation – Diana Macalintal, *Your Parish is the Curriculum: RCIA in the Midst of the Community.* This book helps us to understand our role as Missionary Disciples while welcoming others to join our faith community.
