2) During the Season of Lent, our faith community join with Daryl McNiece in this season of renewal in our baptismal commitment. We shall use the Cycle A readings for the 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Sundays of Lent. Scrutinies will be celebrated for the Elect, so as to strengthen and purify their conviction to follow Christ and turn away from sin.

3) What are the scrutinies? Our Elect will make the resolve to scrutinize their lives, turning away from sin and embrace the way of life as followers of Christ, as the baptized are also called to Lenten Renewal during this joyful season as Disciples of Christ.

4) We shall have a **Lenten mini-retreat from Monday to Wednesday, March 25-27.** Please come and participate at 7:00pm each evening.

**On Monday, March 25** we shall look at Liturgy and Initiation. We explore why the Rite of Adult Initiation calls all the baptized to engage in initiation. I shall explore with you various liturgical practices, such as the significance of the communion procession at Mass; why we baptize at Mass; why Christian initiation is connected with the Community. These issues help to enhance our participation at Mass.

**On Tuesday, March 26,** through a DVD called Fatal Flaws, we come to know how doctor-assisted suicide diminishes the dignity of human life in nations such as Belgium, Holland, U.S. and our own country.

**On Wednesday, March 27** we celebrate a community Lenten Reconciliation Service with an opportunity for individual Reconciliation.

5) We invite parishioners to come and support our Elect at the Easter Vigil: Leah McNiece and Celia Cheung. Please pray for them as they seek to follow Our Lord Jesus Christ in their journey to complete their initiation and live the Christian way of life! Daryl McNiece will also complete his initiation through Confirmation and First Communion.
