1) Throughout the Easter Season, we shall be using the Blessing and Sprinkling Rite at our Masses as a reminder of our baptism, following the recommendation of the church's general instruction. We place the holy water receptacle and pastoral candle near the ambo to highlight this special liturgical season.
