1) Next weekend, **November 11/12** parishioners will have an opportunity to assist in various ministries and services. Please consider exercising your discipleship: part of our effort of implementing the diocesan vision of Missionary discipleship.

2) Do you know that the Initiation of Adults is **a process** rather than a course, as many of us believe? A course has a time-frame (beginning and ending), and a teacher to give it, (e.g. dating is a process, not a course). When a couple starts dating, they do not know how long it will last, nor do they plan a wedding date right away. Similarly, those who come to us requesting baptism are actually discerning whether to have a life-long commitment to Jesus Christ and the faith community (the Church). Our responsibility consists of mentoring them to our Christian Way of Life as Disciples of Christ. We mentor them through introducing them to what we do: we worship on Sundays (the Day of the Lord), we show them how to follow the Mass; we introduce them to the culture of the parish: with our worship, devotions and special events; we coach them to serve the community (working at the bazaar, parish dinners) so that they know that Christians are called to serve one another (including the poor and the needy); we form them to be attentive to God's Word, to pray (listen and communicate with God), to a conversion of values and transformation of their lives gradually in conforming with the demands of the Gospel. This process of grace depends on their participation, just as the duration of dating lasts as long as it takes. In order to prepare parishioners to enter into this exciting process of welcoming others to our midst, I shall give a **workshop on November 18 to implement his vision.**

3) November is the month of remembrance. We began with the Solemnity of All Saints on November 1st, followed by the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed (All Souls Day). Prayer in communion with the saints and for the deceased, are part of our practice. The remembrance of the deceased by a Mass intention is a long tradition in our Church. During this month, parishioners can inscribe deceased members of their family and friends in the memorial book which is located near the front below the sanctuary.

4) In conjunction with the above, we are having a **Memorial Mass on Thursday, November 9th at 7pm** to commemorate parishioners and Knights of Columbus members who passed to the Lord during this last year. We invite all those who lost a loved one to attend as a gesture of our support, consolation and prayers. Please call the parish office to let us know if the funeral of your loved one did not take place in the church.

5) Following Fr. Terrence Fournier's talk on liturgy and devotions, our Liturgy Committee will meet and make appropriate changes to help us foster a spirit of devotions leading us to a better participation at our liturgy. I would like to thank all those who participated. For further reference, refer to: "Directory on Popular Piety and the Liturgy: Principles and Guidelines," from the Congregation for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments, with address by Pope John Paul II, December 2001.

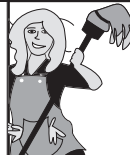
