LRT UPDATE: The Parish's Sub-Committee met with Councilor Theresa Kavanagh and LRT Office representatives on August 15, 2019. East-West Connectors is the primary contractor for Stage2LRT. The work performance requirements for the redesign of the Parish's parking lot are included in the contract signed in February, 2019 between East-West Connectors and the City of Ottawa. A copy of the requirements was provided by LRT Office. Delays in Stage 1 have pushed back the schedule for on-site work which is not likely to commence earlier than 2021. The Parish's storm water management infrastructure requires updating. If practical, this work will be undertaken at the same time as City-funded site improvements.
