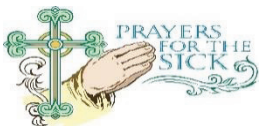

FOOD DRIVE OCT. 1-2 – SUPPORTING OUR LOCAL FOOD BANK: The Our Lady of Fatima “food drive” to support our local Food Bank located at the Britannia Woods Community Centre will be held this weekend during all Masses. The Britannia

Woods Food Pantry provides much needed support to families in the Ritchie Street area and beyond, characterized by social housing for poorer neighbours from all walks of life, including immigrants, refugees, and people living in shelters. If you are able to help our needy neighbours please bring non-perishable food items, toiletries, and/or household cleaning supplies. We also accept cash if you prefer to donate that way. The most needed items at the Food Pantry include **BABY FORMULA**; toiletries such as **TOILET PAPER**; personal hygiene items such as **DEODORANT**, menstrual pads and tooth paste; dry goods such as **OATMEAL** and **FLOUR** and canned goods such as **SOUPS**, **STEWs** and **TOMATO PASTE**.
