Our Lady of Fatima Parish, dedicated to the Mother of God, seeks to fulfill the call of Jesus to “come follow me,” to be true worshippers of the Father through the power of the Holy Spirit, and to love one another as Christ has loved us.



1) Fr. Terrence Fournier, Director of the Liturgy Office at the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops, will host a workshop here in the Parish Hall on **Sat. Oct. 28th after the 9am Mass until 12:30pm**. He will help us understand the relationship between liturgy and devotion, liturgical and devotional liturgical music. We shall also discuss devotions before weekday Masses, as well as Our Lady of Perpetual Help Devotions, so as to help us better connect our devotions and liturgy. All parishioners are encouraged to take part!

2) We are having **anointing of the sick** during Mass on Sat, Oct. 28th at 4:30pm. Our elderly and infirmed parishioners are welcome to take part in this service. To facilitate our proper understanding of the Sacrament of the Sick, I would ask you to read this, taken from *Pastoral Care of the Sick: Rites of Anointing and Viaticum*: General Introduction.

Recipients of the Anointing of the Sick: The Letter of James states that the sick are to be anointed in order to raise them up and save them. **Great care and concern should be taken to see that those of the faithful whose health is seriously impaired by sickness or old age** receive this Sacrament. A prudent or reasonably sure judgment, without scruple, is sufficient for deciding on the seriousness of an illness; if necessary a doctor may be consulted.

The **Sacrament may be repeated if the sick person recovers after being anointed and then again falls ill or if during the same illness the person's condition becomes more serious**. A sick person may be anointed **before surgery whenever a serious illness is the reason for the surgery**. **Elderly people may be anointed if they have become notably weakened even though no serious illness is present**. **Sick children are to be anointed if they have sufficient use of reason to be strengthened** by this Sacrament.

3) Many thanks for those who volunteered as extra-ordinary ministers of communion. We shall consider having a Ministry Fair, part of our effort of implementing the diocesan vision of Missionary Discipleship.

4) In conjunction with the diocesan vision of missionary discipleship, we have a number of inquirers who are discerning whether to become Catholics. As all the baptized are called to be a welcoming presence, I am trying to get parishioners to mentor them in this process of discipleship. I shall give a workshop on November 18 as a follow-up. Details to follow.
