SAVE THE DATE - SPECIAL COLLECTION NOVEMBER 5-6th: Dioceses across Canada, in their continuing journey of seeking reconciliation with Canada's Indigenous Peoples, have committed to contributing \$30 million over five years in new funding to facilitate further reconciliation efforts. The Archdiocese of Ottawa-Cornwall has pledged to raise \$1.2 million. The name of our campaign is "**Christ-Centered, Co-Journey Towards Healing**".

On November 5th and 6th, the Archdiocese will hold a special collection. All the money raised during the campaign will stay in our local communities. Indigenous Groups and Organizations such as Kateri Native Ministry located in Ottawa and the North American Travelling College located in Akwesasne will be able to apply for grants for such things as culture and language revitalization, education and community building. Projects may include programs that offer training and leadership formation to Indigenous communities, curation of oral histories and a curriculum for school-aged children to teach language and share their Indigenous culture.
