If you have already booked an intention but have not yet made your offering please make arrangements to do so before the scheduled date so that you can be sure the intention will be prayed for.

WHY DO I NEED TO SIGN IN AT MASS? Ottawa Public Health requires all places of worship to maintain an attendance log for purposes of contact tracing in case of an outbreak. **This is for your protection so that they can contact you if necessary.** Please sanitize your hands and look for your LAST NAME on the list, then place a checkmark beside your name. If you cannot find your name please print it on the blank sheet provided, along with your phone number. The usher will then guide you to your seat. We want to keep each other safe. Here are some of the changes you can expect:

- You will be asked to **please stay home** if you exhibit any of the symptoms of flu or COVID19 including fever, sore throat, coughing, sneezing.
- You must wear a mask or face covering when you attend and you are asked to please bring your own sanitizer as well, if possible. Otherwise sanitizer will be available at the entrance & exit doors.

You do not need to register for Mass, however you must provide contact information as per Ottawa Public Health. We do not want to turn anyone away but we are limited to 100 people – please be patient as we move forward. Unfortunately the washroom is only available for emergencies as it needs to be sanitized after each use. We are complying with directives from the Archdiocese and health regulations. **Our volunteer ushers will direct you to your seat. 1) Reflection for the 25th Sunday in Ordinary Time:

Often we treat God's gift as something we earn, as exemplified by the parables about the wages of labourers: they arrive at different hours and expect to be paid accordingly.

2) We are grateful for the volunteers who exercise their discipleship during this critical time who assist us so that we can ensure the safety and security of our parishioners. Please wear a personal mask/face cover to protect yourself and others and have available sanitizers. **We are in need of more volunteers to relieve and divide responsibilities. Our volunteer team is working hard to address the reliability of the livestream connection. We are aware that it does not always function as hoped – please be patient as we continue our attempts to provide this service to you.

5) Printed copies of the bulletin are now available. Please pick up your copy as you leave the Church.

6) The province now requires contact-tracing for worshippers in the event someone is found to be a carrier of the virus. Please co-operate with us so that we can respond to this safety measure which is also sanctioned by the Archdiocese.

7) Naga Lakshmi, our elect, will be received into the Church through sacraments of initiation on Sunday October 4 at the 10:00am Mass. Please pray for her as she continues her journey in discipleship.

8) Please make an effort to be punctual for Mass as a courtesy to the hospitality ministers so they can participate at Mass without being interrupted. During the Liturgy of the Word you will have to wait at the entrance until the liturgical action is finished.

9) Please pray for the repose of the souls of Marion Cordick and Lorraine Small. Their funerals were held here last week.
