



WELCOME!

The Cathedral Basilica of Christ the King is the principal church of the Diocese of Hamilton and home to the Bishop of Hamilton. The word "cathedral" comes from "cathedra" or Bishop's chair located in the church. On February 25th, 2013, in recognition of the significance of its design, and its importance in the Diocese, the Cathedral was given the status of a *Minor Basilica* by Pope Benedict XVI. The Cathedral Basilica was completed in 1933, and is a very beautiful structure that is reflective of the lively faith of its parishioners and the entire Diocese of Hamilton.

The Cathedral Basilica's *Coat of Arms* presents a shield sheltered by the *ombrellino*, and with crossed keys representing the papal designation of basilica status. The shield has a symbol for Christ with the crown of thorns and the crown of glory. The motto in Latin *- every eye shall see him*.



If there are several intentions for a particular Mass, the priest retains one, the remaining donations are sent to the Chancery Office for the education of future Priests in our Diocese. At the Cathedral, our Saturday 5:00 p.m. and Wednesday 12 Noon Masses are "multi-intentional" Masses. An announced Mass is satisfied with the printing of the weekly bulletin.

CO-OP MISSION APPEAL

The annual Co-op Mission Appeal will be preached in our Parish the weekend of **July 14**. This year we welcome *Father Tulio Ramirez* of the Yarumel Missioners. This community, founded 97 years ago, brings the Gospel to people who have yet to hear it proclaimed. They work in Angola, Bolivia, Columbia, Ecuador, Ivory Coast, Kenya, Panama and Thailand. RCIA

The *Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults* will resume in our Parish in September. This is a graced opportunity for adults who desire the Catholic faith through **Baptism, Confirmation,** and **Eucharist**. Adults in our Parish who have not been fully initiated are invited to contact Father Wynen at the Parish Office to explore the possibility of participating in the process this coming year. Usually, the Sacraments of Initiation are celebrated with adults at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. The RCIA is a process of reflection and significant Rites leading to the celebration of Initiation.
